(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

SALTERS LANE NORTH, DARLINGTON

Darlington Borough Council has made an Order under the provisions of Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily introduce the following restrictions to allow road surfacing works:

SALTERS LANE NORTH

Phase 1

No stopping and no waiting at any time; and the prohibition of the driving of vehicles from North Road junction eastwards to Oakwood Drive junction and no right turn from Oakwood Drive onto Salters Lane North

Phase 2

No stopping and no waiting at any time; and the prohibition of the driving of vehicles from Oakwood Drive junction eastwards to the north side of Thompson Street East junction and no left turn from Oakwood Drive onto Salters Lane North

Only one phase will be in place at a time. Access for residents only when works allow.

An alternative route will be signed via Whinfield Road, Stockton Road, A66, B6279 Tornado Way, Haughton Road, Freeman's Place, A167 St Cuthbert's Way, Northgate, High Northgate, North Road and vice versa.

The maximum duration of the temporary restrictions under this Order is 18 months commencing from 29th July 2024, it is anticipated that the restrictions will be effective for 2 weeks.
