ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

(TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE) 2024

ARKENDALE STREET AND ST ANDREW'S STREET, DARLINGTON

Whereas the Borough Council of Darlington, being the Highway Authority, is satisfied that such restriction is necessary to allow works by Northumbrian Water to carry out a sewer survey, the Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14(2) of The Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, hereby gives notice of the temporary closure of:

ARKENDALE STREET – Entirely

ST ANDREW'S STREET

From its junction with St Paul's Terrace northwards to the southern boundary of 1 St Andrew's Street

ASKRIGG STREET SOUTH BACK

From its junction with Pendleton Road South westwards to the eastern boundary of 4 Askrigg Street

ST PAUL'S TERRACE BACK STREET NORTH – Entirely

ARKENDALE STREET AND ST ANDREW'S STREET BACK STREET – Entirely

PENDLETON ROAD AND ARKENDALE STREET BACK STREET – Entirely

The maximum duration of the temporary closure under this notice is 5 days commencing from 4th June 2024, it is anticipated that the closure will be effective between 0900hours and 1600hours for one day on 4th June.
