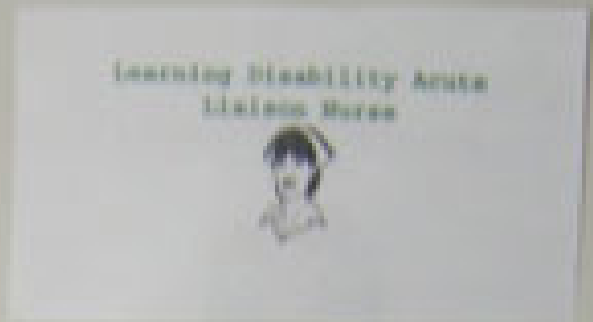

Section 2: History of signs and symptoms (When did you first notice the problem, etc.)

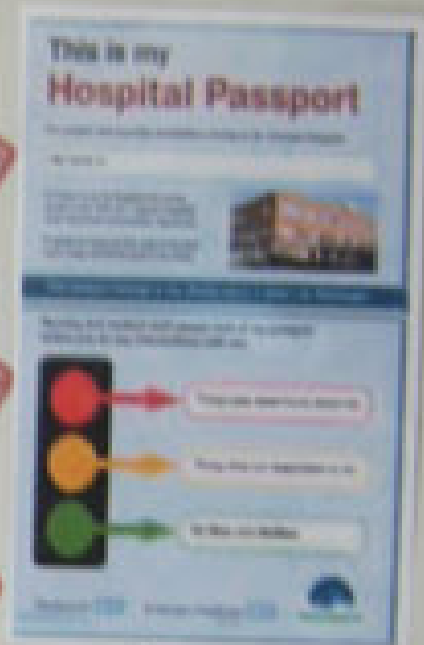

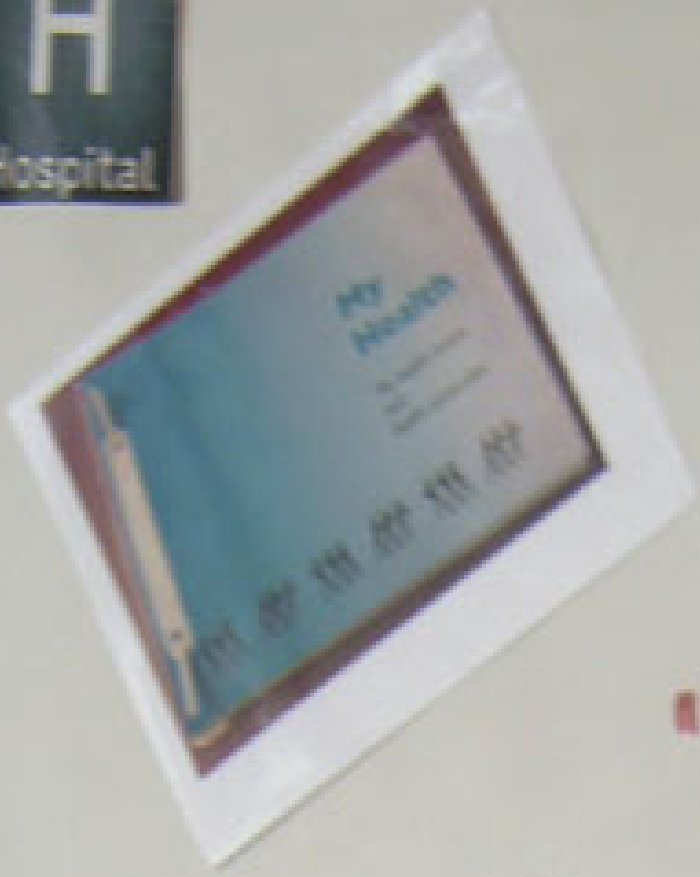

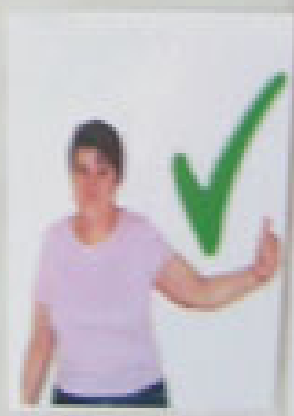


Reasonable Adjustments

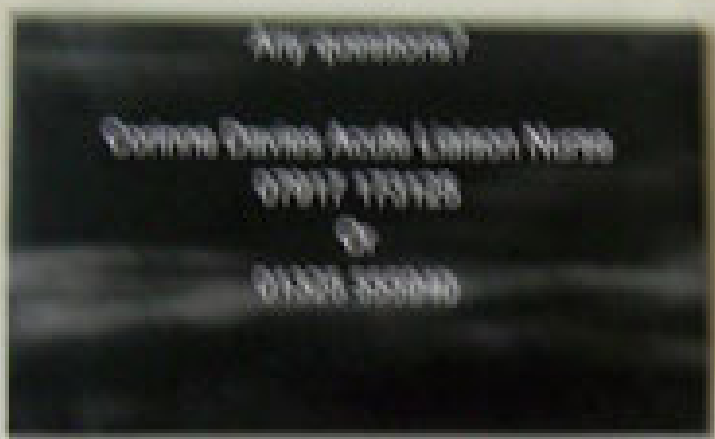


Six Lives Update

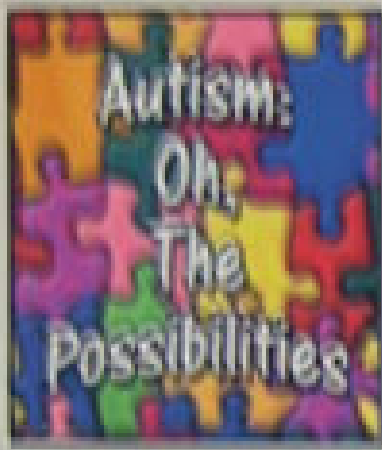

Autism Strategy



- Published March 2010, identifies 5 main areas of work to be done.
- Increase understanding and awareness
- A clear pathway to diagnosis
- Better access to support to live in the community
- Greater access to employment
- Support local partners to develop services and support

Autism Act 2009

- Published by the Government in November 2009 - said two main things:
- The Government would produce an adult autism strategy by April 2010
- There would 'Statutory Guidance' for Local Authorities and Health bodies by 31st December 2010



Delivery Plan

- Lead for autism
- diagnosis → pathway by 2013
- support Dept of Health will offer
- Sets out plan for training for staff.



Statutory Guidance

- Local Planning & Leadership
- Commissioning should be based on actual figures
