Certificate Fees from 16th February 2019

The Government have reviewed certificate fees ie. certified copies of a register entry issued by the Registration Service in England and Wales. Whilst the Registration of a Birth or Death remains free of charge, revised certificate fees are introduced from Monday, 16th February 2019. The purpose of the revised fees is to provide a standardised fee and system throughout England and Wales.

Certificates ie. certified copies of an entry made at the time of making a Registration including:

- A new Birth Registration
- A birth Re-registration
- A death Registration
- A Marriage Ceremony
- A Civil Partnership Registration

£11.00 per certificate

Certificates ie. certified copies of any entry made after the registration and whilst the Register entry is in the custody of either the Registrar or the Superintendent Registrar:

Use of either the Priority or Standard Service

Priority Service

Application in person only, made between 10.00 am and 3.00 pm, issue by 3.00 pm next working day and available either by 1st class postage or collection from the Register Office.

Service not available to applications made by post or online.

£35.00 per certificate

Standard Service

Application in person, online or by post, issue within 15 working days and includes 2nd class postage or can be collected from the Register Office between 10.00 am and 3.00 pm.
