Don't miss your chance to get active at the Dolphin Centre!

The Looked After Through Care Team are working in partnership with the Dolphin Centre to ensure children and young people who are receiving support & services from Darlington Borough Council get free or reduce price activities.

Who can have a card?

- A Darlington Looked After Child
- A Darlington Care Leaver
- A Darlington Foster Carer of a Darlington Child
- A Foster Carers own children

What can you access at the Dolphin Centre?

For FREE you can access:

- casual swimming
- swimming lessons*
- access to Under The Sea soft play
- access to Move More sport & activity sessions
- free induction and access to Dolphin Centre Gym (age and time restrictions apply)

Who can have a Darlington Live Card?

- Any Darlington child who is looked after by Darlington Borough Council.
- Any Darlington Care Leaver up to age of 25 years who are receiving support from Darlington's Leaving Care Team and their children.
- Any foster carers employed by Darlington Borough Council – the card can ONLY be used when accompany a Darlington foster child/young person to participate in an activity, such as swimming.
- Darlington Borough Council foster carers own children
- Any Darlington child who is subject to a Special Guardianship Order (SGO) or is living with Connected Carers and any other children living in that household.

Activity Terms & Conditions

Swimming lessons can only be accessed by children & young people who are looked after by Darlington Borough Council.*

How do you get a Live Card?

If you do not already have a Live Card speak to your worker, for example Social Worker, Personal Advisor or Supervising SW and ask them to contact livercard@darlington.gov.uk to request a card.

Once it has been confirmed you qualify for a card your details will be forwarded to the Dolphin Centre and when the card is ready to collect your worker will let you know.

The cards have a 12 month review date. If your circumstances remain the same the card will automatically be renewed. If your circumstances change, for example a child is no longer Looked After or when a Care Leaver turns 25, we will write and let you know when the card is due to expire.
