

MEMORIAL PLAQUES

Memorial Wall (New Garden)

Situated within the New Garden of Remembrance (opposite the cemetery car park), is an eight-sided memorial wall. The base of the wall is seasonally planted by Council staff, and the whole area is surrounded by a wall of flower vases to enable you to leave floral tributes.

Different sides of the wall hold various granite plaques either six/three line black plaques with gold leaf lettering or six/three line black or red plaques with relief lettering.



Memorial Wall (Old Garden)

This small memorial wall is positioned at the far end of the Old Garden of Remembrance (behind the Crematorium). The wall has a central planter which is filled with grasses and shrubs and maintained by Council staff.

Plaques are of black granite and are crafted in either relief lettering or gold leaf.

All wall plaques can accommodate either six or three lines of text and are fixed in position using stainless steel screws.



Should you wish to proceed in purchasing a memorial plaque in either of the Gardens of Remembrance, please ensure you observe the notes overleaf and complete the relevant application form enclosed in this pack.

Assistance in completion of the form can be sought from the Crematorium Office.

Memorial Planters (New/Old Gardens)

Situated within both the New and Old Gardens of Remembrance, these large octagonal planters are tastefully planted with seasonal flowers and can accommodate up to 48 memorial plaques. At the base of the planter is a small bud vase for a single stem flower to be left in memory of your loved one.



The memorial plaques are of red granite and are in relief lettering which ensures the plaque face will never deteriorate. Each plaque can accommodate three lines of text and is fixed to the planters using stainless steel screws.

Should you wish to proceed in purchasing a memorial plaque for the planter, please observe the notes below then complete the relevant application form enclosed in this pack.

Assistance in completion of the form can be sought from Crematorium Office.

Memorial Kerb Vase

Kerb vases are only available in the Children's Garden of Remembrance. Existing vases can be relinquished (sold back to the Council) or the inscribed plaque can be replaced. For further information contact the office.

Notes

1. The plaques are purchased with the space being leased for 7, 14 or 21 year periods. Once the term of the lease expires an opportunity will be given to secure extra years.
2. Costs associated with the plaques are shown on the enclosed price list and will take approximately eight weeks from receipt of order however you will be notified either by phone or letter of its fixing.
3. Plaques will be fixed to the planter or wall in the next available position chosen by the Council, although you will need to indicate which garden you require the plaque to be located.
4. All planting will be carried out and maintained by Council staff.
5. The single stem bud vase at the base of the planter is for your use, however, if other plants/flowers/ornaments are left in the area of the planter and are deemed to be causing an obstruction to other plaques or interfere with maintenance they will be removed and repositioned.
6. When your chosen lease expires, a renewal letter will be sent to the last known address. If you do not renew for an extended period the plaque will be removed and the position used again. The plaque will be stored for a period of 6 months only. It is in your interest to ensure we are informed of any change of address.
7. The Council accept no responsibility for damage or vandalism caused to the plaque or other items left in the Gardens of Remembrance.
