- Access to Information

- Clear roles and responsibilities
- Good governance arrangements
- Memorandums of understanding

- Must have Rules and Policies
- Communicated to ALL users



6

- Policies in place on information
- Information deleted when not needed

- Restricted Access
- Clearly defined rules
- Specified purpose or law enforcement

- Consider approved standards
- Maintain standards



9

- Safeguards
- Secure against unauthorised access




10

- Effective review and audit mechanism
- Ensure legal compliance
- Regular reports

- Evidential value
- Legitimate aim



12

- Supporting information
- Accurate
- Relevant
