All Functional Skills classes are free of charge providing you meet the following criteria:

- Are aged 19 years or above
- Have been a UK, EU or EEA resident continuously for the previous three years
- Have the right to live and work in the UK, EU or EEA

If you do not meet any one of the three criteria listed, each level you study will be charged at £135
