**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**  
**(TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE) 2021**  
**SALTERS LANE, DARLINGTON**

Darlington Borough Council has made an Order under the provisions of Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to close:

**SALTERS LANE**

**From a point 392metres south of the roundabout at Yarm Road southwards to its end**

The maximum duration of the temporary closure under this Order is 18 months commencing from 25<sup>th</sup> October 2021.

**TEMPORARY BRIDLEWAY CLOSURE**

**Bridleway 39 Darlington from Bridleway 2 Hurworth northwards for 70metres and the footpath at the southern end of Maidendale Nature Reserve from its junction with Bridleway 39 Darlington, westwards for 60metres**

An alternative route for pedestrians will be signed via Footpath 3 and Footpath 4 Hurworth and Footpath 41 Darlington.

The maximum duration of the temporary bridleway closure under this Order is 6months commencing from 25<sup>th</sup> October 2021.

The Order is necessary to allow drainage works
