CREATION ORDER 2018

This Order is made by Darlington Borough Council under Section 26 of the Highways Act 1980 because it appears to the authority that there is a need for the bridleways and footpath described in the Schedule to this Order and it is satisfied that the bridleways and footpath will add to the safety, convenience and enjoyment of a substantial section of the public and has considered the effect which the creation of the bridleways and footpath will have on those with an interest in the land.

BY THIS ORDER

There shall at the end of 14 days from the date of confirmation of this Order be the public bridleways and public footpath over the land situate in Archdeacon Newton and High Coniscliffe, Darlington described in the Schedule to this Order and shown on the Map attached hereto.

SCHEDULE

BRIDLEWAYS AND FOOTPATH TO BE CREATED

Bridleway No. 9 Archdeacon Newton	Starting at Point E, NZ 25353 16343 going west across a field and then along the former Barnard Castle trackbed to Point F, NZ 24790 16399 at the parish boundary. Width – 3 metres
Bridleway No. 16 High Coniscliffe	From Point F, NZ 24790 16399 at the parish boundary going west along the former Barnard Castle trackbed to Point G, NZ 24410 16412. Then turning south east and terminating at Point H, NZ 24514 16304 on Staindrop Road. Width – 3 metres
Footpath No. 10 Archdeacon Newton	Starting at Point A, NZ 25448 17201 going south west through the farm to Point B, NZ 25372 17154. Width – 2 metres

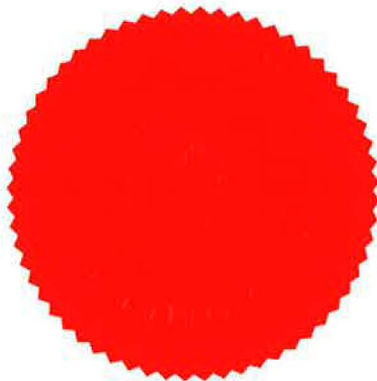
