

**DARLINGTON BOROUGH COUNCIL
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
(TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE) 2021
SALTERS LANE, DARLINGTON**

Darlington Borough Council has made an Order under the provisions of Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to close:

SALTERS LANE

From a point 392metres south of the roundabout at Yarm Road southwards to its end

The maximum duration of the temporary closure under this Order is 18 months commencing from 25th October 2021.

TEMPORARY BRIDLEWAY CLOSURE

Bridleway 39 Darlington from Bridleway 2 Hurworth northwards for 70metres and the footpath at the southern end of Maidendale Nature Reserve from its junction with Bridleway 39 Darlington, westwards for 60metres

An alternative route for pedestrians will be signed via Footpath 3 and Footpath 4 Hurworth and Footpath 41 Darlington.

The maximum duration of the temporary bridleway closure under this Order is 6months commencing from 25th October 2021.

The Order is necessary to allow drainage works
