INDIVIDUAL LIBERTY

We provide opportunities for learners to develop their self-knowledge, self-esteem and self-confidence as individuals across the curriculum.

We promote an understanding of the importance of identifying and combatting discrimination and encourage learners to accept responsibility for their behaviour, show initiative, and to understand how they can contribute positively to the lives of those living and working in the local community and to society more widely.



MUTUAL RESPECT AND TOLERANCE OF THOSE WITH DIFFERENT FAITHS AND BELIEFS

We encourage learners to regard people of all faiths, races and cultures with respect and tolerance. We ensure that ‘respect’ is central to all teaching and learning policy and practice.

We aim to encourage further tolerance and harmony between cultural traditions by enabling learners to acquire an appreciation of and respect for their own and other cultures.



DEMOCRACY

We ensure that all learners within the Service have a voice that is listened to, and we demonstrate how democracy works by actively promoting democratic processes such as the creation of group agreements and negotiated tasks.

Learners will gain an understanding of how citizens can influence decision making through the democratic process.



RULE OF LAW

We embed an appreciation that living under the rule of law protects individual citizens and is essential for their wellbeing and safety and we enable learners to distinguish right from wrong and to respect the civil and criminal law of England.

We encourage an environment where rules and expectations are agreed so that we provide a safe and happy space for all and where differences are reconciled peacefully.
