

Darlington Borough Council Road Traffic Restrictions (Amendment No.1) Order 2022

Notice is hereby given that Darlington Borough Council has made an Order under Sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of the Traffic Management Act 2004. The Order, which comes into effect on the 5th July 2022, will prohibit motor vehicles from proceeding in the following length of road - Houndgate to Beaumont Street Cross Back Street - from a point 12 metres south of its junction with Houndgate to its junction with Beaumont Street. There shall be an exemption for authorised vehicles requiring access to Feethams House. The Order amends the Darlington Borough Council (Moving Traffic) Consolidation Order 2019. A copy of the Order may be examined by appointment (please phone 01325-405492) during the hours of 9am to 4.00pm Monday to Friday inclusive at the Town Hall, Feethams, Darlington DL1 5QT and can be viewed online at www.darlington.gov.uk/transport-and-streets/traffic-regulation-orders-and-consultations If you wish to question the validity of the Order or any provision of it on the grounds that it is not within the power of the relevant section of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or of any requirement of that Act or any enactment made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order you may within six weeks from the date of the Order apply to the High Court for this purpose.
