

Darlington Borough Council Road Traffic Restrictions (Amendment No.1) Order 2022

Darlington Borough Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as 'the Act') and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act and of the Traffic Management Act 2004 hereby make the following Order.

Part 1

Darlington Borough Council (Moving Traffic) Consolidation Order 2019

1. The Darlington Borough Council (Moving Traffic) Consolidation Order 2019 ('the Moving Traffic Order 2019') is amended as follows:
 - 1.1 Article 18 of the Moving Traffic Order 2019 is deleted and replaced by the article set out in Schedule One to this Order
 - 1.2 The length of road detailed in Schedule Two to this Order is added to Schedule 43.02 to the Moving Traffic Order 2019

Part 2

General

2. This Order is entitled the Darlington Borough Council Road Traffic Restrictions (Amendment No.1) Order 2022 and shall come into effect on the 5th July 2022
3. All other provisions of the Moving Traffic Order 2019 not affected by this Order will continue in full force and effect

Schedule One

Added to Moving Traffic Order 2019

18. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed along the lengths of road specified in Schedule 43.02 to this Order at any time SAVE THAT this article shall not prohibit any authorised person requiring access to Feethams House from causing or permitting a motor vehicle to proceed along the following length of road:

Houndgate to Beaumont Street Cross Back Street - from a point 12 metres south of its junction with Houndgate to its junction with Beaumont Street

Schedule Two

Added to Schedule 43.02 Moving Traffic Order 2019

All Motor Vehicles Prohibited

Houndgate to Beaumont Street Cross Back Street - from a point 12 metres south of its junction with Houndgate to its junction with Beaumont Street
