The consultation has raised little concern and most are in agreement with the details within the three plans. One consultation response highlighted the need for ongoing EIA work on particular projects, which will be done to ensure no potential impacts on people with protected characteristics are missed. The three plans will continue to take into account the needs of disabled people and those with protected characteristics, through the plans themselves and through schemes and policies that come from the plans. The aim of all three plans is to make travel within the borough easier and more sustainable for everyone, and we will work to make sure this includes all protected characteristics.
