DARLINGTON BOROUGH COUNCIL ROAD TRAFFIC RESTRICTIONS (AMENDMENT NO.2) ORDER 2023

Notice is hereby given that Darlington Borough Council proposes to make the above named Order under Sections 1, 2, 4, 32 and 35 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of the Traffic Management Act 2004. The following restrictions are being proposed to be introduced:

- No waiting at any time in the following parts of Outram Street:
 the east side, from a point 16.3 metres to a point 22.3 metres north of its junction
 with Duke Street
 both sides, from a point 5.4 metres to a point 10 metres north of its junction with
 Duke Street
- 2. No waiting 8am-6pm Mon-Sat in the following part of Outram Street: the east side, from a point 10 metres north of its junction with Duke Street northwards for a distance of 6 metres
- 3. The following part of Outram Street shall be designated a disabled parking place from 8am-6pm with a maximum wait of 3 hours, and no return within an hour: the east side, from a point 22.3 metre north if its junction with Duke Street to its junction with Duke Street North Back

The Order will amend the Darlington Borough Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading) Consolidation Order 2019; and the Darlington Borough Council (On Street Parking Places) Consolidation Order 2019.
