

**DARLINGTON BOROUGH COUNCIL
(PUBLIC FOOTPATH 6 HURWORTH)
DIVERSION ORDER 2024**

The above named Order made on the 4th March 2024 under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 will divert the length of public footpath described in Part 1 of the Schedule to the route described in Part 2 of the Schedule below. The route of the footpath runs through land at Rose Villa, Timmy's Lane, Hurworth, Darlington DL2 2AJ and can be seen marked on the Order Map. A copy of the Order, the Order Map and a location plan can be viewed on the Council's website at the following address www.darlington.gov.uk/environment-and-planning/rights-of-way and have been placed and may be seen free of charge at Darlington Borough Council, 17 Allington Way, Darlington DL1 4QB from 9.00 a.m. to 4.30 p.m. Mondays to Fridays. Any representations about or objections to the Order may be sent in writing to the Assistant Director – Law and Governance, Darlington Borough Council, Town Hall, Darlington DL1 5QT (ref: AE) or by email to footpathorders@darlington.gov.uk not later than the 5th April 2024. Please state the grounds on which they are made. If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Council may confirm the Order as an unopposed Order. If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for confirmation any representations and objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order.

PART 1

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING FOOTPATH

Footpath No. 6 Hurworth - Starting at Point A, NZ 31203 10276 heading north east through bushes, a garden and a building before proceeding through two hedge lines and finally cross field to Point E at NZ 31309 10347. The width is undefined

PART 2

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW FOOTPATH

Footpath No. 6 Hurworth - Starting at Point A, NZ 31203 10276 heading north along a farm track to Point B – NZ 31212 10395. It then continues east by a field boundary to Point C – NZ 31237 10392 before heading southeast cross field to Point D – NZ 31265 10362. Finally, the path continues cross field east south east to the field boundary at Point E – NZ 31309 10347. The width is 1.5 metres
