

**DARLINGTON BOROUGH COUNCIL
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC & CLEARWAY) ORDER 2024**

Darlington Borough Council has made an Order under the provisions of Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily introduce:

1. no stopping at any time (clearway); and
2. the prohibition of the driving of vehicles on the following roads:

Church Lane, Sadberge	Ramsay Walk
Coombe Drive (eastern boundary of 18 Deepdale Way to end)	Reid Street
Fryer Crescent	Riverside Way
Harewood Hill	Roundhill Road, Hurworth (4 - 28)
Hopetown Lane (Station Road to Farrer Street)	Station Road
Hundens Lane (John Dixon Lane to north side of Arnold Road junction)	Temperance Place
Hundens Lane West Back (42 - 96)	Westcliffe Court (Coniscliffe Road southwards for 16metres)
Kay Grove	Westlands Road
Lindisfarne Court	

The restrictions will be in force for patching works followed by surfacing works at a later date. The exact dates will be notified on site in advance of the works being carried out.

Road Closure

Lay-by off A67 between Merrybent and High Coniscliffe - to allow storage of highway materials

The maximum duration of the temporary restrictions under this Order is 18 months commencing from 13th May 2024.
