DARLINGTON BOROUGH COUNCIL ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 (TEMPORARY ROAD AND FOOTWAY CLOSURES) 2024 WOODLAND ROAD, DARLINGTON

Darlington Borough Council has made an Order under the provisions of Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be:

TEMPORARY FOOTWAY CLOSURES

WOODLAND ROAD NORTH SIDE FOOTWAY

From a point 33metres west of the west side of Hollyhurst Road junction westwards to a point 70metres west of the west side of Dene Grove junction WOODLAND ROAD SOUTH SIDE FOOTWAY

From a point 20metres east of the east side of the entrance to St Teresa's Hospice westwards to the eastern boundary of 187 Woodland Road

The footways will be closed in sections as work progresses, alternative routes will be available on the opposite side of the road.

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURES

Each of the following from their junction with Woodland Road northwards for approximately 25metres, only one junction will be closed at a time: TOWER ROAD, PIERREMONT DRIVE, PIERREMONT ROAD, BRACKEN ROAD, DENE GROVE, PIERREMONT GARDENS, PIERREMONT CRESCENT

The Order is necessary to allow footway and road junction reconstruction works.

The maximum duration of the temporary closures under this Order is 18 months commencing from 5th August 2024, it is anticipated that it will be effective for 10months.
