Darlington Borough Council made an Order on 17<sup>th</sup> October 2024, under the provisions of Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, as amended, the effect of which was to close:

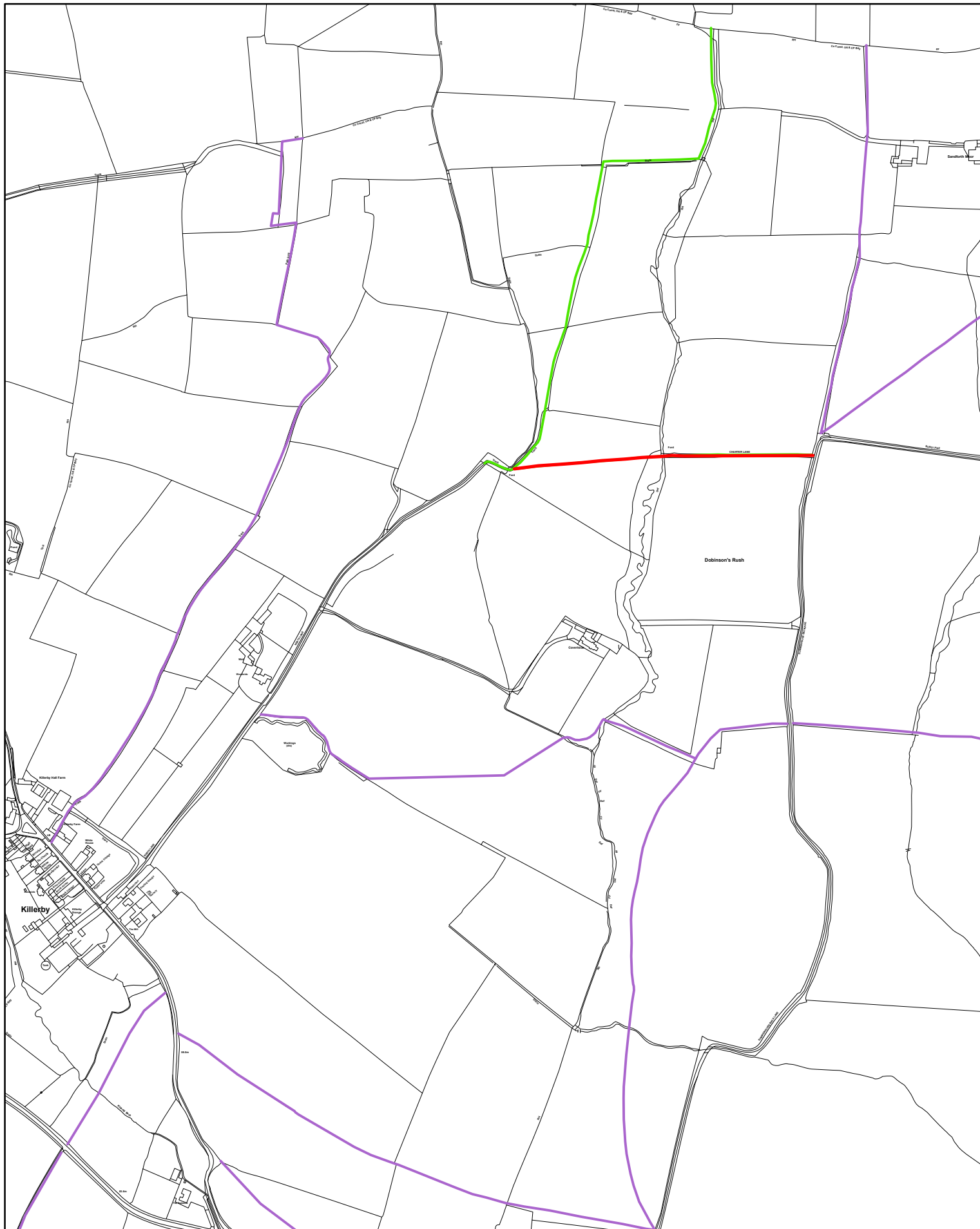
**SUMMERHOUSE BRIDLEWAY 3 – Entirely  
KILLERBY BRIDLEWAY 7 - Entirely**

The Order is necessary due to the unsafe surface of the bridleways.

As the issue is still ongoing the Secretary of State for Transport has granted an extension of the Order until 27<sup>th</sup> October 2026 or until such time as works have been completed, whichever is the earlier.
