ADOPTION STATEMENT DARLINGTON BOROUGH COUNCIL

Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2012

Darlington Council formally adopted its reviewed Statement of Community Involvement (SCI) (Part 1) on 28 July 2016, in accordance with the above Regulations. The SCI sets out the Council's policy for involving the community in the preparation of planning policy and guidance documents. Part 2 of the SCI, which related to Development Management, has not been reviewed. Copies of the newly adopted SCI (Part 1) are available for inspection at the Town Hall, and the town's public libraries. Any person who feels aggrieved by the decision of the Council to adopt its SCI may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of the decision to adopt the statement. Any such application must be made promptly and in any event not later than 3 months after the publication of this notice on 30 November 2016.
