ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND CLEARWAY) ORDER 2025

A68 WEST AUCKLAND ROAD, DARLINGTON

Darlington Borough Council has made an Order under the provisions of Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily introduce:

1. No stopping at any time (clearway); and
2. The prohibition of the driving of vehicles

on the following road:

WEST AUCKLAND ROAD

From the southern boundary of 154 West Auckland Road northwards to the south side of Faverdale Roundabout

An alternative route will be signed via Woodland Road, Bondgate, St Augustine's Way, A167, St Andrews Way (Newton Aycliffe), Heighington Lane, A6072, A68 and vice versa

The Order is necessary to allow road surfacing work.

The maximum duration of the temporary closure under this Order is 18 months commencing from 10th August 2025, it is anticipated that the closure will be effective between 0900 hours and 1900 hours on 10th August and between 1930 hours and 0500 hours on 11th August to 19th August 2025.
