HURWORTH FOOTPATH 11

Whereas the Borough Council of Darlington, being the Highway Authority, is satisfied that such restriction is necessary to allow works to prune the trees adjacent to the footpath, the Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14(2) of The Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, hereby gives notice of the temporary closure of:

HURWORTH FOOTPATH 11

From its start adjacent to 55 The Green, Hurworth southwards for approximately 120metres.

An alternative route is available via The Green, Blind Lane and vice versa.

The maximum duration of the temporary closure under this notice is 5 days commencing from 16th June 2025.
