ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND CLEARWAY) ORDER 2025

WALWORTH ROAD, HEIGHINGTON

Darlington Borough Council has made an Order under the provisions of Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily introduce:

1. No stopping at any time (clearway); and
2. The prohibition of the driving of vehicles

On the following road to allow works to install traffic calming and to carry out road resurfacing.

WALWORTH ROAD

From the south side of South View junction southwards to the north side of the access to Westholme Farm

An alternative route will be signed via A68, A6072, Coatsay Moor Lane, Darlington Road, Redworth Road, Millbank and vice versa.

Access for residents from the north end only.

The maximum duration of the temporary restrictions under this Order is 18 months commencing from 21st July 2025, it is anticipated that it will be effective for 4 weeks
