# HIGHWAYS ACT 1980, SECTION 119

## DARLINGTON BOROUGH COUNCIL (PUBLIC FOOTPATH NO. 12 BRAFFERTON) DIVERSION ORDER 2010

This Order is made by Darlington Borough Council ('the Council') under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 because it appears to the authority that it is in the interests of the owner of the land crossed by the footpath described in paragraph 1 of this Order and it is expedient that the line of the way should be diverted.

#### **BY THIS ORDER**

- 1. The public footpath over the land situate at Newton Ketton Farm, Brafferton, Darlington and shown on the attached map and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order ('the Schedule') shall be stopped up after 14 days from the date of confirmation of this Order.
- 2. There shall at the end of 14 days from the date of confirmation of this Order be a public footpath over the land situate at Newton Ketton Farm, Brafferton, Darlington and shown on the attached map and described in Part 2 of the Schedule to this Order.

#### PART 1

# DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATH

That part of Footpath 12 (Brafferton) starting at a field gate on Salters Lane grid reference NZ31419/20887 (Point A) travelling east south east for approximately 27 metres to NZ31446/20874 (Point B), then north east for approximately 138 metres to a track at NZ31571/20946 (Point C). Width of the path is currently undefined.

#### PART 2

### DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW PATH

Commencing at Salters Lane NZ31482/21050 (Point D) then south west along a track for 138 metres to NZ31571/20946 (Point C). Width of the path to be 2 metres.
