

DARLINGTON BOROUGH COUNCIL
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND CLEARWAY) ORDER 2025
CLEVELAND TERRACE AND ABBEY ROAD, DARLINGTON

Darlington Borough Council has made an Order under the provisions of Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to temporarily introduce:

1. No stopping at any time (clearway); and
2. The prohibition of the driving of vehicles

on the following roads to allow works to install traffic calming and to carry out road resurfacing.

CLEVELAND TERRACE

From its junction with Carmel Road North eastwards to the west side of Neville Road junction

An alternative route will be signed Neville Road, Abbey Road, Carmel Road North and vice versa.

ABBAY ROAD

From its junction with Carmel Road North eastwards to the west side of Neville Road junction

An alternative route will be signed via Neville Road, Clareville Road, Carmel Road North and vice versa

The maximum duration of the temporary restrictions under this Order is 18 months commencing from 4th August 2025. It is anticipated that the restrictions on Cleveland Terrace will commence on 4th August for 3 weeks and Abbey Road will commence on 25th August for 1 week.
