

**DARLINGTON BOROUGH COUNCIL
(PUBLIC FOOTPATH NO. 1
PARISH OF WHESSOE)
DIVERSION ORDER 2014**

This Order is made by Darlington Borough Council under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 because it appears to the authority that it is in the interests of the owners and occupiers of the land crossed by the footpath described in paragraph 1 of this Order and the public and it is expedient that the line of the footpath should be diverted.

Network Rail have agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this Order and any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the footpath into a fit condition for use by the public.

BY THIS ORDER

1. The public footpath over the land situate in the Parish of Whessoe and shown on the attached map and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order ('the Schedule') shall be stopped up after 14 days from the date of confirmation of this Order.
2. There shall at the end of 14 days from the date of confirmation of this Order be a public footpath over the land situate in the Parish of Whessoe and shown on the attached map and described in Part 2 of the Schedule.

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING FOOTPATH IN THE PARISH OF WHESSOE

Footpath No. 1	Starting at Point A (NZ 29796 18561) then south for approximately 100 metres along the west side of the East Coast Main Line to Point B (NZ 29827 18475). The width is unspecified.

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW FOOTPATH IN THE PARISH OF WHESSOE

Footpath No. 1	Starting at Point A (NZ 29796 18561), then east for approximately 6 metres to Point C (NZ 29804 18565), then south for approximately 100 metres to Point D (NZ 29836 18475). The width is 2 metres.

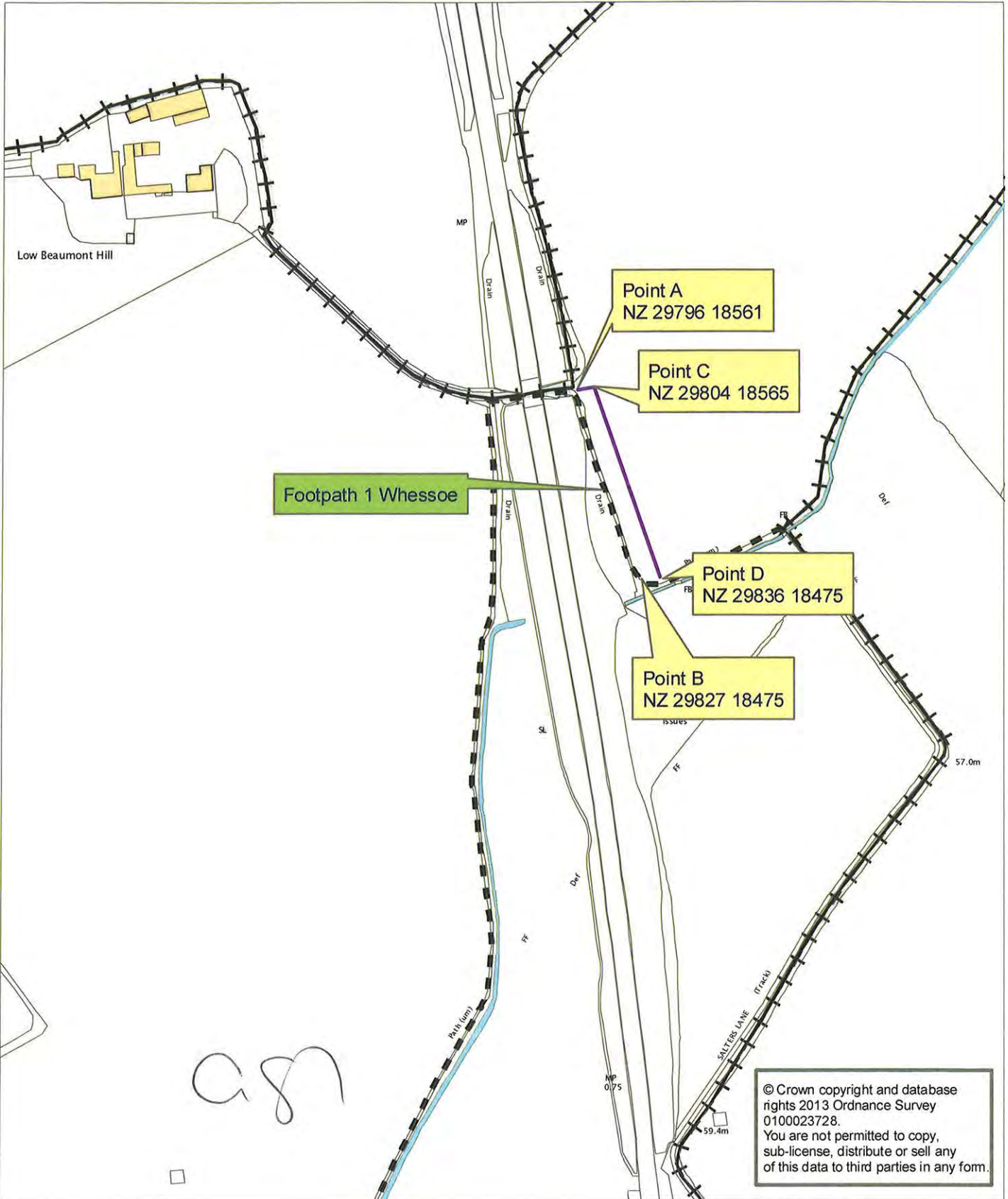


Public Footpath
