DARLINGTON BOROUGH COUNCIL (PUBLIC FOOTPATH NO. 66) CREATION ORDER 2017

This Order is made by Darlington Borough Council under Section 26 of the Highways Act 1980 because it appears to the authority that there is a need for the footpath described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order and is satisfied that the footpath will add to the convenience and enjoyment of a substantial section of the public and has considered the effect which the creation of the footpath will have on those with an interest in the land.

BY THIS ORDER

- 1. There shall at the end of 14 days from the date of confirmation of this Order be a public footpath over the land situate to the east of the Moorfields Estate, Darlington described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order and shown by a purple line on the Map attached hereto.
- 2. The rights conferred on the public under this Order shall be subject to the limitations set out in Part 2 of the Schedule.


