Who are Lifeline Services?

Lifeline is a Darlington Service that offers you the reassurance to live independently. Our dedicated local response team are available 24 hours a day, every day of the year with a simple touch of a button. Giving you the peace of mind that help is there when you need it.

How does the Lifeline work?

A pendant is worn on the wrist or around the neck and once the pendant is pressed a call activates to our Darlington Control Centre. This is via your telephone line or through a wireless connection. The trained operators answer these calls 24/7 where they can offer support and advice. If you are unwell, anxious or have fallen and need some direct support someone will come to your home if you need it.

What is Telecare?

In addition to the standard Lifeline box and pendant we can also install a range of equipment known as Telecare, some of the Telecare range can be seen in the house below. This can automatically activate to our control centre operators, your family or carer.

This technology offers extra independence and peace of mind. It allows the user to live safely in their own home or supported accommodation. There is no need to worry about being unable to get the help and support required when needed.
