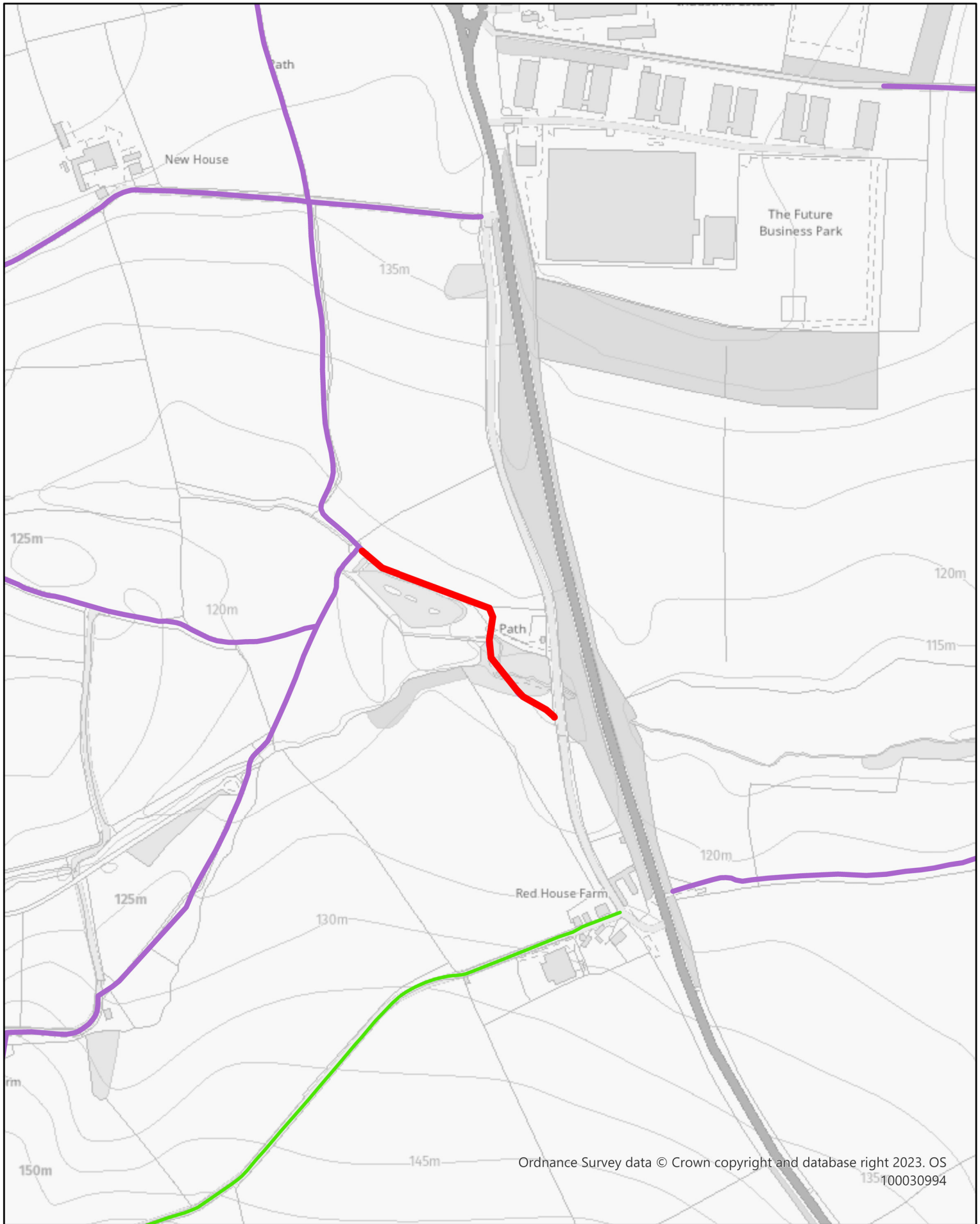
**HEIGHINGTON FOOTPATH 26**
