Books of Remembrance

Books of Remembrance provide a beautiful and lasting memorial to perpetuate the memory of a loved one.

The Books are handmade and lettered by highly skilled craftsmen and are displayed in protective oak cabinets.

Open daily from 9am - 5pm the Remembrance Room is situated to the front of the Crematorium building in the grounds of West Cemetery.

The name of a loved one can be recorded on any day of the year that has special significance such as birthday, date of death or wedding anniversary.

Entries of five lines or more can feature a special emblem, such as a flower or bird, badge or crest which is hand painted at the side. Examples, for information, are shown and staff are available at the crematorium office if you require assistance in composing a suitable entry.

To ensure an entry is produced in time for display, the completed application must be received at the office **no later than six months** before the anniversary.

Should you wish to make an entry, please complete the application form provided and send to the Crematorium Office.

Personal memorial Cards are available and inscribed individually with the verse of choice.

Personal photographs can be added to either of these Memorials to create a unique commemoration of your loved one.
